Mike Farrell asked why voters at the library election were not asked to sign in.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Rick reported that one of the employees working on the library building was involved in an incident at the Adirondack Hotel, where he and another employee have been staying while in Long Lake. Both of the employees of the subcontractor were told they would no longer be welcome at the Hotel. A letter was sent to both the Contractor, Mid State, and the Architect about the incident. Ryan from Mid State contacted Carol Inserra, the Owner of the Hotel, and

Rick spoke with Andre, the Hotel employee involved in the incident. They stressed that the two people involved are not library employees, but employees of the Subcontractor.

Kristel has been attending Webinars. The ALA Conference will be done virtually this year.
