MANAGER'S REPORT:

Kristel reported that she has applied for a mini grant from the ALCA SCR (Statewide Community Regrants). Approval will be determined in January. Camille will ask the Friends to cover the costs that will not be covered by the grant.

Covid cases are increasing, and the statewide mask mandate is in effect. The library has been requiring masks, so nothing will change in the building.

On December 22, 2021, the children in grades Pre K through 6 will come to the library and will receive books and grab n go kits.

Nancy Halter had an artist meet and greet on December 15, 2021

Kristel reported that starting sometime in 2022, JA will no longer pay for internet for all libraries. Internet is now considered a utility. They will still service equipment, including routers, and address security. JA will work with the library to negotiate bandwidth and pricing. The JA fee is currently about \$1800 per year. This fee will be reduced by \$241 annually to about \$1558. Kristel has been in contact with the NNLM (Network of the National Library of Medicine) to determine if the library could provide tele-health equipment at the library for patrons. Funding is available

Kristel also reported that the Patron policies are now on the website, ensuring that the library is adhering to the NYS Library Minimum Standards.
