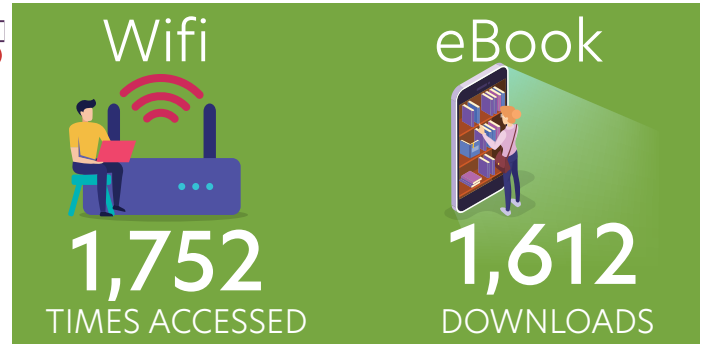

Highlights

- *Awarded a Generous Acts grant from Adirondack Foundation to fund the cost of internet, for a full year, to "Bridge the Digital Divide"
- *Awarded \$2000 to purchase books on nutrition and health through the National Library of Medicine
- *Collaborated with Friends of Library to create two, \$500 student scholarships for graduating seniors in Newcomb and Long Lake school districts.
- *Collaborated with Caitlin Stewart of Hamilton County Soil and Water for an autumn themed story time for the Long Lake Central School students
- *Creation of "Library of Things" with binoculars, puzzles and Chromebooks
- *Farm to Library, sponsored by the Friends of Library, returned for a second year.
