PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Rick reported that a 12 month CD in the amount of \$125,000 at 4.5% has been opened. The CD used funds from the Capital Fund.

The two CDs should generate approximately \$16,000 in interest

Approved: On Motion by Rick, seconded by Bob, with all in favor of approving using \$1,000 of the money in the Tom Helms' Memorial Account to have Jamie Sutliff carve a wooden replica of the **Helms Aero Service airplane**. The plane will have a Helms banner and hang from the ceiling.

The remainder of the funds will be used to fund computer technology.

Melissa Grant has created a portrait of Bob; the original has been sent to the Tice family. The plaque will have a smaller version of the portrait and room for the names of the honorees on plates. The portrait will cost about \$100.
