Richard said that the residents who come to the library to vote are in favor of the library, and he feels that they would not object to going over the tax cap

MANAGER'S REPORT:

Kristel has not yet heard from the Auditor.

She reminded the Board that they need to schedule 2 workshops by the end of 2024

Robyn, the Colgate Fellow, is conducting 3 programs each week Tuesdays – Crafts Wednesdays – Toddler Storytime Thursdays – Babies
She is also designing a Friday activity for teens
Robyn and Kristel are working on Robyn's research project. She is collecting data which will give the library information on demographics and library usage

Rick is coordinating a Dungeons & Dragons event, and also a weeklong Comic Book Camp

Kristel is promoting events in the local newspaper, the library webpage and the Mountain Times

The Friends Art Show in August will have an auction of wood bowls. Other vendors will also be present

One Long Lake student applied for the Friends scholarship, and the student will receive \$500

The Book Nook shed has arrived. The Friends are projecting to open it during the town wide garage sale.

No student applied for the summer seasonal position

Kristel has submitted the SALS Construction Grant proposal for a sump pump

32 people have signed up for Hoopla

The lawyer has not yet responded to the request for a document detailing the Library/Masons arrangement

Kristel thanked Donna for organizing to have students receive library cards

Sara Dallas will be joining the November 19, 2024 Board Meeting

The library needed to call John Adams to unclog the toilet from its use by the SALS delivery person.

Kristel reported that all employees have completed Sexual Harassment and Cyber Security training.

She thanked Mary Elizabeth for her years of serving on the library board.

Results were as follows: 35 voters in person; 1 absentee voter The Budget passed. 34 Yes Votes and 2 No Votes
