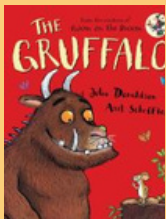


The Library Scavenger Hunt is back again this year!

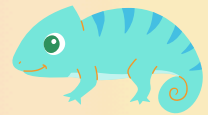

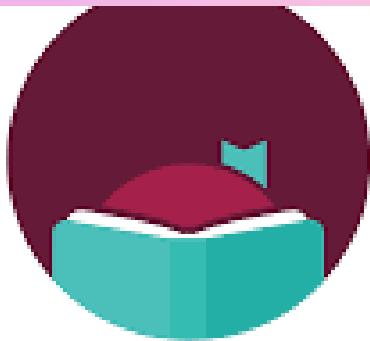
